Plays multiple female & male roles.*

**BORDERLANDS by Eric Samuelsen | Directed by Jerry Rapier
March 31-April 10, 2011 (rehearsals begin March 8, 2010)**

A play about coming out - just not in the usual sense. Set on a used car lot in Provo, Utah, it's a play about all the other ways people come and the hard work of carving out a social space for those for whom none exists in Mormon culture. Role available: *Gail, Caucasian female, Late 30's/early 40's. Mormon divorcee questioning her faith.*
